CIRCULAR

Graduation Day 2024

It is hereby informed that the Graduation Day for the Final Year Students will be held on Saturday, 1st June 2024 as per the following schedule;

@10.30 AM: CSE, E&CE and AIML Departments

@2.30 PM: EEE, ME and Civil Departments

All the students are required to register compulsorily using the Google form in their respective departments.

Note: Students without registration will not be allowed for the function.

Instructions to students for Graduation Day:

1. Graduation robes will be provided between 8.30 am to 9.30 am in the morning session and between 1.00 pm to 2.00 in the afternoon session.
2. Students must occupy their seats in the auditorium before 10.15 am in the morning session and before 2.15 pm in the afternoon session. After these timings, students will not be allowed in the auditorium.
3. Occupy the seats as per the Seating arrangements made.
4. The tassels on the hoods should be worn on the right before the Oath ceremony and then should be worn on the left side after the oath ceremony.
5. Please note that we will not be able to accommodate anyone who does not adhere to formal Dress Code (Boys in formal dress with shoes and Girls with Sarees).
6. A candidate can be accompanied by a maximum of two persons only (parents or grandparents/Adult blood relations). Children below age group of 12 years will not be permitted to sit inside the graduation venue.
7. Please stand when the Graduation procession enters the venue and remain standing until the dignitaries take their respective seats. The same procedure is to be followed when the Graduation procession leaves the hall.
8. You are requested to maintain absolute silence for upholding the dignity and decorum of the function. No one is allowed to leave the hall once the ceremony starts till the graduation procession leaves the hall.
9. Indecent behaviour like whistling, catcalls, shouting, etc., will not be tolerated. However, one can applaud (clap), if you want to show your appreciation.
10. Cell phones must be switched off during the program.
11. Candidates are strictly forbidden to leave their place until the chief guests and other dignitaries leave the venue after the function.
12. Proceed for Group Photographs section-wise.
13. All those who are in the auditorium including the Graduates and their parents should remain in their places and wait for further instructions after the Graduation Ceremony is completed.
